Pursuant to Article VII Section 7.49 of the Beverly City Ordinances, notice is hereby given that the Beverly Community Preservation Committee will hold a public hearing on Thursday, December 12, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at Beverly City Hall, 191 Cabot Street, 3rd Floor Council Chambers.

Beverly voters adopted the Community Preservation Act (CPA) in the November 2012 election. The CPA establishes a local, dedicated fund for the purpose of undertaking open space, historic preservation, community housing and outdoor recreation projects. Implementation of the CPA is undertaken by the Beverly Community Preservation Committee (CPC), as established by Ordinance passed by the City Council in July of this year. The CPC has been meeting regularly since August to draft the guidelines and criteria. The guidelines establish the public process by which to apply for Community Preservation Act (CPA) funding as well as the criteria and process used by the CPC to select projects for CPA funding.

The hearing will give residents an opportunity to comment on the draft guidelines and criteria as well as give input as to Beverly's needs and possible projects involving open space, historic preservation, community housing and recreation. The draft evaluation criteria will be posted on the CPC's webpage on December 6, 2013 and copies can be obtained from the Planning Department. In addition to the public hearing, written comments may be sent to the Planning Department, 191 Cabot Street, Beverly, MA 01915 by noon on Friday December 20, 2013.
