



Angie Miller's American Idol Hometown Visit

Beverly, MA

Are you coming to see Angie?

If so, it's important that you plan your visit ahead of time and keep some important facts in mind. To help you out we've made a list.

- **Take public transportation.** Beverly is accessible via the Rockport and Newburyport Commuter Rail lines. Recommended stations are Beverly Depot, accessible on both lines and Montserrat Station, accessible on the Rockport Branch. Schedules are available at mbta.com. Distance from Beverly Depot to the parade starting point (City Hall) is a third of a mile and just under two miles to the concert site (Beverly High School). Montserrat Station to the High School and parade route is about one mile each.
- **Park in public parking lots.** Eight public parking lots are available downtown and are free of charge. The Pond Street lots are on the parade route and 1.5 miles from the High School. See the attached map for details. Access to the two events sites from Route 128 is best via Exits 22 (Route 62 East), 20 (Route 1A South) and 19 (Sohier Rd/Brimbal Avenue).
- **Concert site parking is EXTREMELY limited.** Use the public parking lots downtown and walk to the high school. The lots at Beverly High School are small and will be heavily used by equipment for event staging, public safety and the media.
- **Standing Room Only.** The concert will be outside at the high school and viewable from the playing fields. No grandstands or seating will be available.
- **No alcohol allowed.** These are family events. Absolutely no alcohol consumption is allowed. Anyone violating this law will be subject to arrest and full prosecution by the law.
- **Arrive early and enjoy Beverly.** Beverly is home to many restaurants, shops, beautiful parks and beaches, and lots of friendly people. We encourage you to arrive early and take advantage of all we have to offer. Visit beverlymainstreets.org and beverlychamber.com for dining and shopping ideas.
