Who does the recycling?

Green Network eXchange is dedicated to the proper disposing and recycling of computer and electronic waste material. For many years computer monitors, printers, stereos, TVs etc would end up in garbage dumps creating numerous environmental hazards when all of this material can be scrapped and recycled. GNE offers a means by which corporations and employees can arrange to dispose of used and retired electronics in a safe and useful manner.

How much of my e-scrap and/or e-waste is recycled and/or reused?

Green Network eXchange offers an outlet for used electronics and end-of-life IT assets for reuse back into the marketplace. Our mission is to reuse as much end of life electronics as possible. The remaining material that has no remarket value, is sold to metals and plastic partners who have smelters and they melt the material down for reuse.

How does GNE provide complete data destruction?

We provide maximum security and wiping methods to the DoD security standard to insure that all assets have been data sanitized, and are cleared for reuse.
