## Frequently asked questions

### Who does the recycling?

East Coast Electronics Recycling, located in Shirley, MA, is focused on the safe collection and disposal of computers and all other electronic equipment. East Coast Electronics Recycling will service the collection event by collecting, sorting and palletizing your electronics safely and quickly.

Electronics are then processed by SAMR. SAMR (<http://www.samrecovery.com>) owns and operates a registered state-of-the-art 100,000-square-foot facility on 13 acres of property in Lakewood, New Jersey. SAMR is a fully licensed Class D recycler and is registered with the EPA and DEP. SAMR is proactive in its environmental responsibility enforcing a zero-landfill policy in the disposal of all e-waste and is ISO 14001 certified.

### How much of my e-scrap and/or e-waste is recycled and/or reused?

SAMR enforces a zero-landfill policy. This means that 100 percent of surplus equipment is recycled or reused. Equipment is tested by SAMR technicians to determine whether or not it should be remarketed or demanufactured. All demanufactured materials are recycled using the latest electronic recycling techniques.

### How does SAMR provide complete data destruction?

SAMR processes your equipment within 48 hours of its acceptance at their facility. All hard drives are wiped at the facility using the DOD 5220.22-M standard to ensure secure data destruction. If a hard drive is dead, or there is failure with the drive, it will go in for hard drive shredding where everything will be destroyed.
