Water Demand Fee - Ordinance Review

This notice is being posted to alert current or future municipal water service customers of the City of Beverly that the Water Demand Fee Ordinance, including the fees associated with improved water connections, are currently under review for amendment by the City.

The City will continue to charge and accept Water Demand Fees at the current fee schedule up until a revised version of the Ordinance is adopted by the City Council and signed by the Mayor at a time which is yet to be determined but is expected to be within this calendar year.

Applicants requesting connection to the municipal water system prior to the final adoption of a new ordinance and right up until its effective date will not be affected by the ordinance change. Applicants making such a request after the effective date of a new ordinance may be required to pay a water demand fee according to a different fee schedule as determined by the legislative process. If a Water Demand Fee has already been paid, fees will not be incurred or credited to the extent the Ordinance fee schedule has been amended.
