Paper and Cardboard

- Newspapers and inserts
- Magazines and catalogs
- Phone books and junk mail
- Paperboard (cereal and cracker boxes)
- All note paper, copy paper & scrap paper
- Pizza boxes, milk boxes
- Corrugated cardboard (flatten and bundle, cut to less than 36" in any dimension)



Glass, Plastic and Metal

- Glass bottles and jars (all colors and sizes)
- Aluminum, tin, and steel: cans and lids
- Clean aluminum foil
- Plastic containers numbered 
- All plastic food containers



NO styrofoam
NO plastic bags

Recycling Preparation

DOs:

- Recyclable materials can be placed in paper shopping bags or cardboard boxes at the curb -- it is not necessary to use bins or carts
- Paper and cardboard can be bundled together in a paper bag or tied with twine
- Properly bundled paper and cardboard can be placed in bin with other recyclables
- Glass, plastic, and metal can be mixed together
- Place loose containers in recycling bin
- Rinse containers first

DON'Ts:

- No plastic bags or Styrofoam
- No items containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials, even if "dry"
- No broken glass, window glass, dishes, Pyrex or ceramics
- No fluorescent bulbs (see "mercury" note below)
- No TVs, computer monitors or electronics



Recycling Equipment

PAPER RECYCLING CARTS 65 gallon wheeled carts are available FOR PAPER AND CARDBOARD ONLY from the Engineering Department at a discounted price of \$35 (home delivery an additional \$10.00). These carts hold more material than 3 recycling bins and are perfect for households that set out several bins of paper every recycling day. With a cart, paper need not be bundled and the attached cover provides weather protection. Call the Engineering Department for more information at (978) 605-2355.

RECYCLING BINS 18 gallon bins are available at the Engineering Department (\$5.00) during City Hall business hours.

RECYCLING STICKERS are available at no charge from the Engineering Department and may be affixed to conventional barrels for recycling plastic, tin and glass containers.

COMPOST BINS are available for \$40.00 by calling Community Development at (978) 605-2382.

Special Collections and Drop-off Items

LEAF COLLECTION and yard waste is collected on your trash day for several weeks each Spring and Fall. See calendar on reverse for specific weeks for 2014. Must be placed in paper bags or open trash barrels.

ELECTRONICS AND STYROFOAM are accepted at Beverly High School on May 3, 2014. Use the Sohier Rd entrance.

HAZARDOUS WASTE is accepted at Beverly High School on April 26, 2014. There will be a co-pay for this event. Use the Sohier Road entrance. Check our website for an informational flyer as the date approaches.

COMPOST SITE is located at 16 Standley Street. Open Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM beginning March 1 until December 23, 2014 or until first significant snowstorm.

USED MOTOR OIL is accepted weekdays at the municipal garage on Park St. during regular work hours (7:30-3:30 M-F) Call for more information at (978) 921-6053.

MERCURY containing items, including compact fluorescent bulbs, button batteries and thermostats, should be brought to the Health Department at 90 Colon St. DO NOT dismantle mercury containing devices. Call the Health Department at (978) 921-8591 for guidance on disposal of fluorescent tubes and other items containing mercury.

LARGE APPLIANCES AND TVs/MONITORS are collected on the third Saturday of each month by appointment. Some materials require the purchase of a disposal sticker or have restrictions. Call (978) 605-2355 for more information or to schedule an appointment. Deadline for appointments is 11:00 AM on the Friday before collection.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION MATERIALS must be disposed of privately.

CHRISTMAS TREES are collected on your trash day during the week of January 6, 2014. Trees must be free of tinsel, plastic and skirting. The 2015 date for tree pick up is the week of January 5, 2015.

Special Announcements

There is now a combined 5 bag and/or barrel limit for TRASH per paid Family Unit/Business.

The maximum size of bags or barrels is 35 gallons and may not weigh more than 40 pounds.

This rule is rigorously enforced for safety and health reasons.

Yard waste is not acceptable curbside except during Spring and Fall collection weeks.
