**COMMUNITY MEETING
BEVERLY DRAWBRIDGE CONSTRUCTION**

On Wednesday, April 1st, MassDOT, MBTA and HNTB personnel will join area officials for a community meeting to discuss the rehabilitation and replacement project for the Beverly Drawbridge that carries the Rockport and Newburyport Commuter Rail Line over the Danvers River. Specifically this meeting is to discuss the 21 day train service shutdown needed for the project which is anticipated for April 2017.

The project scope has been split into two contracts. The first contract consists of approach span concrete pile repairs and will not require any train service shutdowns. The second contract requires a 21 day train service shutdown (April 2017) to complete the full replacement of the swing span superstructure which includes new mechanical, electrical components and hydraulic wedge and rail system.
