

Beverly City Hall Historic Records Conservation Project 2015 - 2016

This project is intended to continue professional deacidification and conservation of some of the most at-risk municipal records in the care and custody of the City Clerk's Office. The records were surveyed by a professional archival preservation and imaging company in 2011. Those records deemed most in need of attention include Proprietor's Records from 1698 - 1750; Town Records Vols. 4 - 15 (1739 - 1894) and Birth Certificates from 1861 - 1917. These are clearly original, signed documents of significance in the history of the City of Beverly.

The Town Records are in bound journal-sized books. The pages are well maintained but not on acid free paper and, of course, are deteriorating from age and handling. The birth certificates are maintained in an orderly system of wood and metal cases about 3" w x 5" h x 10" d neatly shelved in the City Hall basement vault about 3 ft high and 30 ft in length. Because the records consist of individual, unbound slips of paper, which have been subjected to repeated searching, extraction and return over the years, many have folds and tears, which catch on others when they are searched.

Earlier records, and others in greater need of attention, have been conserved from time to time through a line item in the annual city operating budget, typically of \$10,000. In recent years, however, those funds were first reduced to \$5,000 annually and then eliminated as other operating costs constrained available funds.

This proposal is intended to conserve in bound individually page-sleeved volumes, and to scan to CD or DVD:

Town Records	1739 - 1826	Vol. 4 - 9	5 Volumes
Birth Certificates	1876 - 1887		6 Volumes

The anticipated cost, and requested amount of this grant request is \$25,000, all for third party conservation charges. If the grant is awarded, as many volumes as possible from this list will be conserved. If any funds remain, they would be used to conserve additional volumes from the next succeeding years as far as possible.

This proposed project falls squarely within the Historic Resources/Preservation category of the Community Preservation Fund Allowable Spending Purposes Grid in that it will protect critical City-owned personal property (Vital Records), which are significant in the history of the City, from injury, harm and destruction. These documents are well over 50 years old, rare (absolutely unique) and threatened with further deterioration due to their present non-archival condition.

The City Clerk's Office is required to maintain vital and town records by State law and closely follow the Massachusetts Attorney Generals Office retention schedule.





On behalf of the Beverly Historical Society, I am very pleased to endorse the proposal by Kathleen Connolly, Beverly City Clerk, for a second round of funding for conservation of valuable City records. These records are truly unique, and critical to informed research into many aspects of Beverly's history. As stewards of historic records ourselves, we know how important it is to be diligent about preservation.

Our staff routinely accesses those City records in the vaults and storage areas at City Hall. We see first-hand both the excellent conservation work that has been professionally performed on some of the earliest records, and their availability for research purposes. We receive many inquiries yearly for information that is available nowhere else.

The Society was delighted to learn that CPA funding was received in the first round for this project, which means that town records from 1774-1876 and birth records 1876-1896 are currently being preserved! This is wonderful news. More work needs to be done, however, with many records after those dates still in delicate and deteriorating condition.

In our view, continuing professional conservation is an ideal project for the historic preservation aspect of the Community Preservation Act, and we fully support these efforts. The second phase, which will include volumes through 1899, is equally deserving of support. Dear Kathy:

Thank you for entrusting your records with Kofile Preservation. Preservation work will be completed and your books returned in 18-20 weeks.

Enclosed is the update of my letter dated April 21, 2014. Please note the prices will be honored through December 2015.

As I am sure you are aware, the records surveyed are only a portion of those requiring attention, but are among those most in need of treatment.

Paper was tested with Chlorophenol Red and found to be acidic (below pH 5). Acidity is the major cause of paper deterioration and must be dealt with if the records are to be preserved.

Our recommendations for the conservation of your records include deacidification, mending and reinforcement of paper as necessary (with repair or replacement of index tabs where indicated) resewing, rebinding or archival grade polyester encapsulation, as appropriate. The deacidification process, which halts the inevitable destruction of acidic paper, should be considered whenever conservation or even long term storage of unique records is evaluated.

We appreciate the opportunity to offer our services to your community and hope you will call with any questions or comments.

Beverly Archives Project cataloging the city's historical documents


Members of the Beverly Archives Project are volunteering to catalogue the archival records of the clerk's office in City Hall. The initiative is a direct outgrowth of the survey of records stored in the basement at City Hall that was conducted by professional archivist Kobi Kobialka in 2004 and funded by a grant awarded to BAP by the Massachusetts Historical Records Advisory Board.

Kobialka's survey found that while records were safely stored in the basement, they were not easy to access because there was no systematized storage plan and no one available to help find things. In addition, some records were in need of substantial preservation work due to water damage in years past.

In late 2008, BAP held advisory meetings with City Clerk Fran MacDonald and Assistant Clerk Kathy Connolly to review the situation and suggest possible approaches to preserving and cataloging the collection. In February 2009, work began on indexing and preservation.

Most Friday mornings, volunteers from BAP can be found at City Hall organizing, processing and cataloging the records stored in "Area K," a walk-in safe housing the oldest of the city's records. Aside from moving loose documents to acid-free folders, the processing of the archives includes the removal of dangerous materials, such as staples, rubber bands, paper clips and string, and most importantly, the listing of every document or group of documents on a computer spreadsheet. This spreadsheet, updated weekly and given to the clerk's office, precisely locates each item on the shelves in the safe.

While the primary objective is to preserve, label and organize, it is impossible to ignore the

fascinating content of many of the documents, some which date back to the early 1700's. Included among these are lists of voters (polls) with names and occupations, military service and discharge papers, records of the town's overseers of the poor, town meeting warrants and meeting minutes, deeds, cemetery records, road layouts and servant indentures.

One of the more remarkable documents that recently came to light was a book of registered earmarks used in the 18th- and 19th-Century by residents to mark their livestock. Owners made the prescribed cuts in one of the ears of a cow, sheep or pig in their session so that it could

identified when left in the town's common. If stock left on the common overnight without a registered earmark could by law be taken by the town and sold.


Beverly Archives Project is an association of public, private and religious organizations and its goal is to preserve the rich history of Beverly by preserving organizational documents. BAP has provided over \$300 of materials to the project and volunteers have logged in over 150 hours; many, many more hours ahead. Key volunteers to date have been Margaret Alfonso, Terri McLaughlin and John Thomson.

BAP meets monthly from September to May. Meetings are open to the public and are held on the first Thursday of the month in the Beverly Public Library, 32 Essex St., at 7 p.m. For more about the organization and its purpose, visit <http://www.beverlyarchivesproject.org>.



EXPLANATORY NOTE

This finding aid includes, as of July 2010, all of the historical records of the City Clerk located in either the "safe" on the main floor of City Hall or in the basement vault. The basement vault is referred to as "Zone K" in the Collections and Survey Report dated August 12, 2004 written by K. Kobialka under a grant obtained by the Beverly Archive Project from the Massachusetts Historical Records Advisory Board.

This finding aid does NOT include the various vital records (births, deaths and marriages) maintained by the Clerk's office, other than those particular records encountered in the process of organizing the records found in the basement vault.

In addition to the attached hard-copy, this finding aid is on a computerized database form that is "searchable" for easy access. It is expected to be most beneficial to future historians in that form.

Since records are identified by a specific location, it is crucial to the usefulness of this finding aid, that any and all records be removed only temporarily and that they be returned to their designated space, or if relocated, that the finding aid be updated.

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The Beverly Archives Project, formed in 2002 as an initiative of the Beverly Historical Society, is an association of institutions and individuals concerned with the preservation of Beverly's history through the archives, files, and written records held by its various institutions and residents.

The preparation of this finding aid represents the work of several individual members of the Beverly Archives Project: Margaret Alfonso, Terri McFadden and John Thomson. It involved over 365 person-hours of effort over a period of more than a year, and has been supported in part by donations from the Beverly Archives Project, for conservation materials, and by a grant from the Beverly Cultural Council, for interpretation and publication.
