**Please encourage your friends & neighbors to recycle.**

- Trash & Recycling must be out by **7:00 am** on your scheduled trash day regardless of the time the trucks usually come
- Trash & Recycling shall be put out for collection no earlier than 18 hrs prior to collection & barrels removed 18 hrs after collection per Residential Storage of Rubbish & Garbage City Ordinance Section 14.03
- Recycling is collected every week on your trash day (there is no limit to the amount of recycling placed curbside)
- Recycling bins are available at the Engineering Dept (\$5.00) at City Hall, hours are (Mon-Wed 8:30-4:30, Thurs 8:30-7:30, Fri 8:30-1)
- Yard waste is only collected during weeks marked with a leaf symbol **ON YOUR TRASH DAY** when placed in paper sacks or open barrels & placed near your trash and recycling by **7:00 am**
- Yard waste may also be taken to our Compost Site located at 16 Standley Street (M, Th, Sat 8-3:30, Mar. 7, unless late snow cover, through Dec. 17, unless early heavy snow)

## Paper and Cardboard

- Newspapers and inserts
- Magazines and catalogs
- Phone books and junk mail
- Paperboard (cereal and cracker boxes)
- All note paper, copy paper & scrap paper
- Pizza boxes
- Corrugated cardboard (flatten and bundle, cut to less than 36" in any dimension)



## Glass, Plastic and Metal

- Glass bottles and jars (all colors and sizes)
- Aluminum, tin and steel: cans and lids
- Clean aluminum foil
- Plastic containers numbered  $\triangle 1$  -  $\triangle 7$
- All plastic food containers

**NO styrofoam**  
**NO plastic bags**




## Recycling Preparation

### DOs:

- Recyclable paper products can be placed in paper shopping bags or cardboard boxes at the curb -- it is not necessary to use bins or carts
- Paper and cardboard can be bundled together in a paper bag or tied with twine
- Properly bundled paper and cardboard can be placed in bin with other recyclables
- Glass, plastic and metal can be mixed together
- Place loose containers in recycling bin
- Rinse containers first

### DON'Ts:

- No plastic bags\* or styrofoam\* (see other options below)
- No items containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials, even if dry
- No broken glass, window glass, dishes, Pyrex or ceramics
- No fluorescent bulbs (see 'Mercury' note below)
- No TVs, computer monitors or electronics (see Special Collections section below)



\*Plastic bags can be recycled at local supermarkets & Styrofoam can be recycled in Peabody at LiFoam Industries, call for info 978-278-6215

## Recycling Equipment

**PAPER RECYCLING CARTS** 65 gallon wheeled carts are available for **PAPER and CARDBOARD ONLY** from the Engineering Department at a discounted price of \$35 (home delivery an additional \$10.00). These carts hold more material than 3 recycling bins and are perfect for households that set out several bins of paper every recycling day. With a cart, paper need not be bundled and the attached cover provides weather protection.

**RECYCLING BINS** 18 gallon bins are available at the Engineering Department (\$5.00) during City Hall business hours (M-W 8:30-4:30, TH 8:30-7:30, F 8:30-1).

**RECYCLING STICKERS** are available at no charge from the Engineering Department and may be affixed to conventional barrels for recycling plastic, tin and glass containers.

**CHRISTMAS TREES** are collected **ON YOUR TRASH DAY** during the week of January 4, 2016. Trees must be free of tinsel, plastic and skirting. The 2017 date for Christmas Tree pick up is the week of January 9, 2017.

**COMPOST SITE** (Yard Waste only, NO Food) is located at 16 Standley Street. Open Mon, Thurs and Sat from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM beginning Monday, March 7 (unless late snow cover) until Saturday, December 17, 2016 (unless early heavy snow).

**CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION MATERIALS** must be disposed of privately, search online or in yellow pages for *Trash Removal*.

**ELECTRONICS, STYROFOAM & TEXTILES** are accepted at Beverly High School on May 7, 2016 • 8am-noon. Use Sohier Rd entrance.

**HAZARDOUS WASTE** is accepted at Beverly High School on April 23, 2016. There will be a co-pay for this event. Use the Sohier Rd entrance. Check our website for an informational flyer as the date approaches. For more info contact Health Dept (978) 921-8591.

**LARGE APPLIANCES AND TVs/MONITORS** are collected on the third Saturday of each month by appointment for those who pay a trash fee to the City. Some materials require the purchase of a disposal sticker or have restrictions. Call (978) 605-2355 for more information or to schedule an appointment. Deadline for scheduling appointments is 11:00 AM on the Friday before collection.

**LEAF COLLECTION** and yard waste is collected **ON YOUR TRASH DAY** for several weeks each Spring and Fall. See calendar on reverse for specific weeks for 2016. Yard waste must be placed in paper bags or open trash barrels.

**MEDICATION DROP OFF BOX** located at Beverly Police Station; Sharps (syringes) can be dropped off at the Sharps Kiosk located in the main lobby of Beverly Hospital. Call the Health Department at (978) 921-8591 for more information.

**MERCURY** containing items, including compact fluorescent bulbs, button batteries and thermostats, should be brought to the Health Department at 90 Colon St. DO NOT dismantle mercury containing devices. Call the Health Department at (978) 921-8591 for guidance on disposal of fluorescent tubes and other items containing mercury.

**USED MOTOR OIL** is accepted weekdays at the municipal garage located at 148 Park St. during regular work hours (7:30-3:30 M-F), call for more information at (978) 921-6053.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

**There is a combined 5 bag and/or barrel limit for TRASH per paid Family Unit/Business.**

The maximum size of trash bags or barrels & recycling receptacles is 35 gallons and may not weigh more than 40 pounds.

This rule is rigorously enforced for safety and health reasons.

Yard waste is not acceptable curbside except during Spring and Fall collection weeks. (See reverse for pickup weeks)
