These items are banned from landfills & will not be picked up with your regular trash. Fire Extinguishers (Carbon Dioxide)	These are refillable & should be refilled after each use, check Yellow Pages under <i>Fire Extinguishers-Recharging</i> . If defective, drill holes in the cylinder after pressure has been relieved and place in trash.
