Wednesday, August 21	Names and Addresses of Candidates posted
Thursday, August 22***	5:00 PM Last day and Hour for filing objections and/or withdrawal of Nomination Papers 5:15 PM Drawing for ballot position by the City Clerk in the City Council Chamber - Candidates or their representatives may be present
Wednesday, September 4	8:00 PM Last day to register Voters for the Preliminary Election
Monday, September 23	Noon Deadline for Clerk's Office receipt of Preliminary Election Absentee Ballot Applications

Monday, 30 September	5:00 PM Last day and hour for filing withdrawals or objections to Nominations made at Preliminary, and for filing written Acceptances by write-in or sticker candidates who won in the Preliminary with the City Clerk and Last day and hour to file for a Recount 5:15 PM Drawing for Ballot Positions by City Clerk in the City Council Chamber. Candidates or their representatives may be present
Wednesday, October 16	8:00 PM Last day to register Voters for the Municipal Election
Monday, November 4	Noon Deadline for Clerk's Office receipt of Biennial Municipal Election Absentee Ballot Applications

Tuesday, November 5, 2019 Biennial Municipal Election


