## DIRECTIONS TO OPEN 2019 HHW COLLECTION EVENTS

**Beverly High School, 100 Sohier Road:** *From the south*, take Route 128 North to Exit 19, Brimbal Ave. / Sohier Rd. Stay on Sohier Rd for several tenths of a mile. As you descend the hill, the High School will be on your right. *From the north*, take Route 128 south to Exit 19, Brimbal Ave/ Montserrat. Take a left off the exit, cross over 128 and take your first right and follow to the end and take left onto Sohier Rd. Follow for several tenths of a mile. As you descend the hill, the High School will be on your right. **Contact: Bill Burke at 978 921-8591.**

**Boxford / Middleton / Topsfield: Masconomet High School, Endicott Road, Topsfield:** From Route 95, take Exit 51, Endicott Rd, Topsfield. (From 95 N turn right onto Endicott Rd; from 95 S, turn left). Take the 1<sup>st</sup> driveway to the right on Endicott Road into Masconomet High School. **Contact: Karen Sheridan at 978 887-5519**

**Danvers Transfer Station, East Coast Road:** From Route 1 South, pass Chili's and Harbor Freight Tools and take right onto East Coast Road. Follow the road to the end to enter Transfer Station. **Contact: Gail Bernard at 978-777-0001 x3014.**

**Ipswich: Transfer Station, 180 Town Farm Road:** From Route 95 North OR South – Take Exit 54A/Route 133 East toward Rowley and stay on 133E for 4.2 miles. Take right onto Route 133E/Route 1A South/Main Street. Drive 1.9 miles, past Ipswich Middle/High School on right. Immediately after crossing over bridge (be prepared to stop!), take left onto Town Farm Road. Drive 2.2 miles to the end. **Contact: Marlene Connelly at 978-356-6612**

**Lynn: DPW, 250 Commercial Street, Lynn:** From Route 1 Saugus – Southbound or Northbound: take Walnut Street exit towards Lynn. Turn right on Kirtland Street. Take 1<sup>st</sup> left onto Marion Street. Turn slight right onto Federal Street. Turn slight left onto Market Square. Stay straight to go onto S. Common Street. Take 1<sup>st</sup> right onto Commercial Street. After crossing over the Lynnway (Route 1A), Lynn DPW will be on your left. **Contact: April Peralta at 781-268-8000 ext. 12**

**Melrose: DPW, 72 Tremont Street:** From Route 1 South in Saugus – Turn right onto Essex Street (after Square One Mall). Stay straight on Essex for 1.9 miles (at 0.9 miles Essex St becomes Upham St.). Turn right onto Bellevue Ave. then take an immediate left onto E. Emerson St. Follow E. Emerson St. for 0.6 miles, then turn right onto Tremont St. DPW entrance will be on the left in 0.2 miles. \*Please note that Tremont St. will be ONE-WAY for this event, with NO TURNING onto Tremont from Lynn Fells Parkway. Drivers approaching from Lynn Fells Parkway will need to pass Tremont St. then take an immediate left onto Vinton St, followed by another left onto W. Emerson and another left onto Tremont after crossing the railroad tracks. **Contact: Melrose DPW for details at 781-665-0142**

**Newburyport: DPW Yard, 16 A Perry Way:** From Rte 95, take exit 57 / Rte 113 east towards Newburyport.

**Coming from the North:** take left at light onto Rte 113 east. At 2<sup>ND</sup> set of lights -gas station on right- take right onto Low Street.

**Coming from the South,** take right onto Rte 113 east. At first set of lights – gas station on right- take right onto Low Street.

Go 1.5 miles on Low Street. Take right onto Perry Way. DPW will be down on your right.

**Peabody Public Services Yard, 50 Farm Avenue:** From Route 1 North, take right onto Forest Street. Go past the Allied Waste Transfer Station and take second right onto Farm Ave. First building on the right is DPS. **Contact: Peabody Health Department at 978 538-5926.**

**Saugus High School, Pearce Memorial Drive:** From Route 1 Saugus – Southbound or Northbound: get off the highway at the Main Street exit/ overpass. Travel east toward downtown. ## What Hazardous Products Can I Bring?

### General Household Materials

- Acids (corrosives)
- Aerosol cans (excluding empty cans)
- Art supplies
- Batteries - Alkaline batteries manufactured before 1994 and all NiCad, button, zinc and lithium batteries
- Chemistry set chemicals
- Fiberglass resins
- Furniture, floor, metal polishes and strippers
- Hobby supplies (rubber cement, airplane glue etc.)
- Mercury containing devices (switches, thermostats, fluorescent lamps, compact fluorescent bulbs (energy efficient bulbs), broken fluorescent bulbs, thermometers, blood pressure equipment)
- Moth balls/crystals
- Oil paint and paint thinners, varnish, stain and shellac (no Latex Paint is allowed)
- Paint Strippers
- Photography chemicals
- Rug and upholstery cleaners
- Solvent adhesives
- Turpentine and other paint solvents
- Wood preservatives

### Lawn and Garden Materials

- Cesspool cleaners (corrosives)
- Flammable liquids/Gasoline
- Flea and tick powders
- Fire starters
- Fungicides
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- No-pest strips
- Pesticides
- Poisons
- Pool chemicals
- Propane tanks, empty or partially empty, up to 20 lbs\*

### Bathroom Products

- Hair dye
- Nail polish remover
- Toilet cleaners

### Laundry Materials

- Brighteners
- Chlorine bleach
- Spot removers
- Spray starch
- Whiteners

### Kitchen Materials

- Drain cleaners
- Lighter fluids
- Oven cleaners

### Automotive Products

- Antifreeze
- Batteries (autos, motorcycles, etc.)\*
- Brake fluid
- Carburetor cleaner
- Oil - used
- Radiator flush
- Solvents and degreasers
- Tire cleaners
- Transmission fluid
- Waste fuels (gasoline, kerosene, etc.)

## Do Not Bring:

- Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives
- Asbestos
- Commercial hazardous waste
- Construction waste/building materials
- CRT's, CPU's, computer monitors, television sets etc.
- Empty aerosol cans
- Fire extinguishers
- Gas cylinders (other than propane)\*
- Infectious or biological wastes - [medical waste](#) can be dropped off on scheduled collection days
- Latex Paint - dried out latex paint can be disposed of with your regular trash curbside
- Medicines or syringes - [medical waste](#) can be dropped off on scheduled collection days
- PCB's
- Radioactive materials
- Smoke Detectors
- Tires

## \*Additional Cost

## To Ensure Safety:

- NEVER MIX CHEMICALS
- NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous materials
- Do not place waste in plastic garbage bags
- Tighten caps and lids leaving material in original labeled containers
- Sort and pack paint, pesticides and household cleaners separately
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper
- Pack your vehicle and go directly
