



## City of Beverly Cemetery Department Covid-19 Funeral Update

Funerals and Graveside services can take place with the following Requirements and Understanding:

- Service is limited to 50 attendees \*see reverse
- Services will end promptly 45 minutes from the scheduled start time
- Limit the number of speakers to the smallest possible as to not run past the 45-minute allotted time
- Tents are prohibited and restrooms are not available

Attendees at all Beverly Public Cemeteries:

- Must abstain from attendance if Covid-19 symptoms are present or have been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for the Covid-19 virus
- Required to wear face coverings at all times
- Required to adhere to the 6ft Social Distancing Policy at all times

This form must be completed and submitted with all Orders of Interment

\*Per the Governor's August 7th COVID-19 Order No. 46, outdoor gatherings, even for religious activities, are limited to 50 persons. All participants must maintain 6 feet of physical distance from all other participants not from the same household. If the gathering is larger than 10 people, everyone over the age of two must wear a face covering. The penalty is a fine not more than \$500 per violation. The Board of Health and Police are authorized to enforce the order. Regarding indoor religious activities, gatherings are capped at 50% of permitted capacity or 10 persons per 1,000 square feet of accessible space, (in both cases, staff included).
