 - a. **Google Hangouts Meet meeting login instructions:**
 - i. For computers, browse to the following web address: meet.google.com/kzr-mech-jea
 - ii. For mobile devices (tablets and iPhones/smartphones):
 1. Please go to either 'Google Play' [Android] or the iOS 'App Store' [iPhones and iPads] and download the free program 'Google Meet.'
 2. Allow the program to access your device's camera and microphone.
 3. Then click 'Enter a meeting code' and type in 'kzr-mech-jea.' Then click 'Ask to join.' A facilitator will enable you to enter the meeting.
 - b. **Telephone: For standard telephones and cell phones:**
 1. Dial the number 1 909-687-0297.
 2. When prompted, enter the PIN: 834 134 910□#. A facilitator will enable you to enter the meeting.
